Dear Single Haul & Oversized/Overweight Permit Users,

In fulfillment of the Mayor's Order, the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), Public Space Regulation Division (PSRD), will temporarily provide limited blanket approval for single haul carriers driving oversized and overweight vehicles on roads controlled by the District, for the express purpose of ensuring that emergency essential supplies and services reach impacted areas in a timely manner in response and support to areas affected by COVID-19. Motor carriers and drivers qualifying for this blanket approval must still comply with DDOT hauling and safety guidelines, and follow an approved truck route, which can be generated through the link below. Motor carriers and drivers must have the approved truck routes with them while operating in the District of Columbia under this blanket approval. This blanket approval is effective immediately through April 12, 2020.

Motor carriers and drivers must also still abide by posted restrictions on all structures, such as tunnel height limits, as well as bridge formula weights. Click <https://routeplanner.ddot.dc.gov/routeplanner/> and select "Guest Access" to generate your route.
