**SUSPENSION OF WORK IN THE DISTRICT  
Thanksgiving Day  
November 28, 2013**

In observance of Thanksgiving Day, and pursuant to section 103.01 Article 17 item C of the District's Manual for Standard Specifications for Highways and Structures, all non-emergency work in the streets and sidewalks within the District's right-of-way will be suspended as of Wednesday, November 27th, 2013. This includes manhole access. Crews may resume work beginning Friday November 29th, during their permitted working hours.
