SEVERE WEATHER ADVISORY NOTICE: Suspension of Public Space Permits for Curbside Use in the District of Columbia

Tuesday, January 26, 2016

Effective immediately from Tuesday, January 26, 2016 to Sunday, January 31, 2016

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

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(Washington, DC) Due to snow removal operations, the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is suspending public space permits for curbside use until Sunday, January 31, 2016.

The permits affected by this suspension include **Moving Storage Containers and Moving Trucks, Weddings and other One Time Non-Recurring Events, Other Special Events, Mobile Crane Work Zones, and New Roll Off Debris Container permits.**

This action is necessary to allow District agencies to continue its snow plowing and snow removal efforts in the safest and most efficient manner. People who have paid for permits and cannot reschedule will be issued refunds once they surrender the permit. People who have paid for their permits and can reschedule are asked to contact the Public Space Permit Office at (202) 442-4670 for assistance.

The Department of Public Works and the Metropolitan Police Department have been notified that *Emergency No Parking* and *Reserved Parking* signs associated with these permits are not to be enforced.

Additional restrictions may be required to assist or allow with the snow removal operations.
