Suspension of Work in the District of Columbia

Extended Observance of Thanksgiving Day Thursday, November 23, 2017 through Friday, November 24, 2017

In observance of Thanksgiving Day and pursuant to section 103.01 Article 17 item C of the District's Standard Specifications for Highways and Structures and in accordance with Mayoral Direction, there will be an extended suspension of work in the District from 12:00pm Wednesday, November 22, 2017 through Friday, November 24, 2017. **Lane closures will not be allowed for non-emergency work in roadways and sidewalks within the District's Right-of-Way.** This includes manhole access and construction related deliveries.

Approved activities may resume beginning Saturday, November, 25, 2017 during permitted work hours.
